ORDINANCE NO. 1548

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE V, CHAPTER 52 OF THE CITY OF RED BUD CODE OF ORDINANCES 2021 PERTAINING TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud has the power to appoint officers with the advice and consent of City Council; and

WHEREAS, the method of making this appointment is not efficient; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud finds that there is a need, and that it is in the best interest of the City of Red Bud to formally revise the procedure for appointing officers and their successors; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BUD, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance as though written herein verbatim.

SECTION 2: That Section 52-1(C) of Chapter 52 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Red Bud is repealed and replaced with the following:

<u>52-1 (C)</u>: With recommendation by the Chief of Police, all subordinate officers shall be hired by the Mayor, by and with the advice and consent of the City Council.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance supersedes all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances adopted prior hereto that are in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and signature by the Mayor.
