ORDINANCE NO. 1552

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A FLAME RESISTANT CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT POLICY

WHEREAS, the importance of flame resistant clothing and equipment has been discussed for the safety of city workers in the gas department;

WHEREAS, a Flame Resistant Clothing & Equipment Policy concerning the gas department has been presented to the City Council for Approval; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud has deemed it in the best interest of the City to approve the Flame Resistant Clothing & Equipment Policy.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BUD, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: The City of Red Bud, Illinois hereby accepts the Flame Resistant Clothing & Equipment Policy, attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof, as regulation upon the gas department of the City.

SECTION 2: The Flame Resistant Clothing & Equipment Policy shall be administered by the City Superintendent.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance supersedes all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances adopted prior hereto that are in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.





Clothing Purchases

- City Provided Items will be provided at no cost to the employee. Should clothing or equipment need to be replaced, the damaged clothing or equipment shall be turned in to the City Superintendent. Upon approval, the clothing or equipment shall be replaced and the damaged clothing or equipment shall be disposed of.
- City and Employee Partnership Items will be on a shared 50% - 50% basis. Should clothing need to be replaced, the damaged clothing shall be turned in to the City Superintendent. Upon approval, the clothing shall be replaced and the damaged clothing shall be disposed of.
- Employee Provided Items will be 100% the employee's responsibility.

Flame Resistant (FR) Clothing Requirement Locations

FR Clothing shall be worn at all locations as required by any pipeline company and when performing covered tasks as noted in the City of Red Bud's Operations, Maintenance, and Emergency Manual.

Retirement/Termination

All City provided items shall be returned to the City Superintendent upon retirement/termination.
