
I further certify that on May 1, 2023 the Corporate Authorities of the above municipality passed and approved Ordinance No. 1519 entitled:

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WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 includes Title X which involves business regulations generally; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 includes Chapter 105 which involves regulations of Farmers' Markets within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City amended the Zoning Code which changed provisions relating to Farmers' Markets; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud has deemed it in the best interests of the City to amend the regulations of Farmers' Markets to conform to the Zoning Code.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BUD, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance as though written herein verbatim.

SECTION 2: That Section 105-2 of Title X, Chapter 105 of the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 of the City of Red Bud, Illinois be repealed and replaced with the following:

105-2: APPROVAL REQUIRED.

(A) It shall be unlawful for anyone to operate a Farmers' Market in the City without obtaining the approval of a majority of the City Council each calendar year. If the location of a Farmers' Market changes during the year after initial approval, then the new location must be approved by the City Council as well before operations may begin at the new location.

(B) Any operator of a Farmers' Market shall first comply with all requirements of the Zoning Code. Then the operator shall send their request for approval to operate a Farmers' Market along with the location and all rules, regulations, policies, requirements, waivers, and applications which will be used by the operator to the City Clerk.

(C) The City Council, in their sole discretion, shall approve or deny all requests to operate a Farmers' Market.

SECTION 3: That Section 105-3 of Title X, Chapter 105 of the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 of the City of Red Bud, Illinois be repealed and replaced with the following:

105-3: OPERATION.

(A) The operation of a Farmers' Market shall be in accordance with all laws, rules, and regulations, including those of the State of Illinois, City of Red Bud, Illinois Department of Public Health, the Randolph County Health Department, and any successors.

(B) The operation of a Farmers' Market shall only be allowed in areas according to the Zoning Code. Any special considerations required under the Zoning Code shall be addressed with the Code Administrator and the Planning Commission.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance supersedes all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances adopted prior hereto that are in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and signature by the Acting Mayor.
