CHAPTER 134: OUTDOOR FURNACES

**134-1: DEFINITION.** “Outdoor Furnace” as used in this Article means any equipment, device, structure or apparatus, or any part thereof, which is installed, fixed or situated outdoors for the primary purpose of combustion of fuel to produce heat or energy used as a component of a heating system providing heat or hot water for any interior space, primary structure, or accessory use, but does not include the use of propane, acetylene, natural gas, gasoline or kerosene in a device intended for heating and temporary construction or maintenance activities.

**134-2: OUTDOOR FURNACES PROHIBITED.** The installation and use of outdoor furnaces is prohibited.
