Old Business

I. Comprehensive Plan Update

The Planning Commission will be meeting tomorrow to accept the final review of the Comprehensive Plan.

New Business

I. Approval of Prior Month's Meeting Minutes – Meeting October 20, 2025
Recommendation made by Committee Member Nevois, seconded by Committee Member Guebert, to approve the minutes from the October 20, 2025, meeting. Carried

II. City Hall Improvement – Tuckpointing – Quadrant Contract

Code Admin. Mueller said that originally only the east wall was going to be tuckpointed, but it was decided to wait until city hall was waterproofed completely and then do the tuckpointing. Quadrant is asking for \$16,500 to prepare documents, plans, and do some quality control. Quadrant's estimate for the tuckpointing is \$135,000 for all walls. The window contractors finished the tuckpointing under the windows, except for one parapet.

Recommendation made by Committee Member Nevois, seconded by Committee Member Guebert, to authorize approval of the proposal for Quadrant Design for architectural services on the city hall tuckpointing project, NTE \$16,500. Carried

III. Red Bud Business Park Covenants

Code Admin. Mueller included a sample covenants for the RBBP for discussion. Some recommendations were restricting front of building facades, what the building is constructed of, especially on the frontage lots, parking lot

surface, smells. Noise levels and barriers between the business park and likely future residential areas are already covered by ordinances.

Recommendation made by Committee Member Mueller, seconded by Committee Member Nevois, to authorize approval for Jeff Mueller to work with the city attorney to draw up a RBBP covenants. Carried
