ORDINANCE NO. 1561

**AN ORDINANCE CHANGING
TITLE XV, CHAPTER 153 OF THE CITY OF RED BUD
CODE OF ORDINANCES 2021
PERTAINING TO SCHEDULE “F” PARKING ZONES**

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 includes Chapter 153 which involves Parking Regulations; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 153 includes rules and regulations for parking included as Schedule “F” Parking Zones; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud finds that there is a need to update the Parking Zones as stated in Schedule “F” due to changes and improvements around said Parking Zones; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud has deemed it in the best interest of the City to amend Schedule “F” Parking Zones.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BUD, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance as though written herein verbatim.

SECTION 2: That Section IV. Restricted Parking of Schedule “F” Parking Zones of Chapter 153 of the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 be amended as follows:

IV. RESTRICTED PARKING.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 153-3, the following streets are hereby designated as “Restricted Parking Zones”, and it shall be unlawful to park a vehicle according to the following restrictions:

East S. 6th St. (south side) from S. Main St. to Bloom St. as extended easterly, during school hours except for loading and unloading passengers.

Hazel St. (west side) from the south line of West S. 5th St., north ninety-five (95) feet during school hours except for loading and unloading passengers.

W. Field St. (north side) from Locust St. to Janice St. from seven-thirty o’clock (7:30) a.m. to three-thirty o’clock (3:30) p.m. on school days.

On the parking lot on the north side and adjacent to the Post Office for any period longer than fifteen (15) minutes in any consecutive two (2) hour period.

On the east side of Bloom St. in the first 100 feet south of E. Market St., for any period longer than thirty (30) minutes in any consecutive two (2) hour period.

On the east side of Bloom St. starting one hundred (100) feet south of East Market St. and continuing for twenty-five (25) feet, only for police vehicles at all times.

On the northeast corner of the City Hall Parking Lot located at 200 E. Market Street.

The following streets shall be restricted to parking for the users of St. Peter's United Church of Christ and the residents who live along said streets described below, to-wit:

<u>STREET (SIDE)</u>		<u>LOCATION</u>
W. Field St. (South)	From	Locust St. to Janice St. (for any period longer than 30 minutes during school hours)
Madison St. (Both)	From	Pine St. to Olive St.
Pine St. (Both)	From	Madison St. to Phillips St.
Randolph St. (Both)	From	Madison St. to Phillips St.
Randolph St. (Both)	From	Madison St. to end of Randolph St.

SECTION 3: That Section VI. Handicapped Parking of Schedule "F" Parking Zones of Chapter 153 of the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 be amended as follows:

VI. HANDICAPPED PARKING.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 153-3, it shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle which is not bearing registration plates or decals issued to a handicapped person, as defined by 625 ILCS 5/1-159.1, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/3-616 or 625 ILCS 5/11-1301.2 or to a disabled veteran pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/3-609, in the following street areas:

<u>STREET (SIDE) / PARKING LOT</u>		<u>LOCATION / NUMBER OF SPOTS</u>
Bloom St. (East)	From	A point fifty (50) feet South of E. S. 4 th St. to a point one hundred twenty-five (125) feet South of E. S. 4 th St.
E. S. 1 st St. (South)	From	A point one hundred (100) feet East of S. Main St. to a point one hundred thirty-five (135) feet East of S. Main St.
E. S. 6 th St. (South)	From	A point one hundred eighty-five (185) feet East of S. Main St. to a point two hundred twenty-five (225) feet East of S. Main St.

Locust St. (East)	From	A point thirty-five (35) feet North of Brand Ave. to a point sixty-five (65) feet North of Brand Ave.
Locust St. (East)	From	A point forty (40) feet South of Brand Ave. to a point sixty (60) feet South of Brand Ave.
Madison St. (West)	From	A point eighty-five (85) feet North of Randolph St. to a point one hundred fifteen (115) North of Randolph St.
Randolph St. (North)	From	A point thirty (30) feet West of Madison St. to a point eighty (80) feet West of Madison St.
City Hall Parking Lot (200 E. Market)		One Spot
City Parking Lot (W.S. First Street/S. Main Street)		One Spot
Ratz Park (603 W. Market Street)		Four Spots - Main Parking Lot – Two Spots - Between Pool & Splash Pad – Two Spots
Library Parking Lot (925 S. Main Street)		One Spot
Lincoln Park (525 W.S. 4 th Street)		Seven Spots
Utility Office (525 Power Street)		One Spot
Dashner Building/YMCA (130 S. Oak Street)		One Spot

SECTION 3: This Ordinance supersedes all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances adopted prior hereto that are in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and signature by the Mayor.




