ORDINANCE NO. 1566

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 71 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO ELECTRIC RATES

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 includes Chapter 71 which involves city utilities; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 71 of Title VII sets electric rates for customers of the City of Red Bud; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bud has deemed it in the best interests of the City to amend the electric rates for proper revenue and maintenance of the electric system for the benefit of the City and its customers.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RED BUD, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance as though written herein verbatim.

SECTION 2: That as of May 1, 2026, Section 71-28 of Title VII, Chapter 71 of the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 of the City of Red Bud, Illinois be repealed and replaced with the following:

71-28: RATES AND CHARGES. For the following classifications of electric service, the rates, based on the conditions and terms as set forth are hereby established for the sale of electric energy to the City's customers unless otherwise agreed upon.

(A) Rate I -- Residential Rate:

Customer Charge	\$11.50 per month
All KW-HRS used per month	\$ 0.1214 per KW-HR

The minimum monthly bill shall be Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$11.50) per month. Rate I shall apply to residences and churches.

(B) Rate II -- Commercial Rate:

Customer Charge	\$21.50 per month
All KW-HRS used per month	\$ 0.1386 per KW-HR

The minimum monthly bill shall be Twenty Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$21.50) per month. Rate II shall apply to stores, shops, garages, depots, public halls, hospitals, mills, factories, pool rooms, taverns, soft drink parlors, restaurants and other places of business, public resort or amusement.

(C) Rate III -- Small Power Rate:

Customer Charge	\$57.00 per month
All KW-HRS used per month	\$ 0.1212 per KW-HR

The minimum monthly bill shall be Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$57.00) per month. Rate III shall apply to all customers, unless otherwise agreed to, having a monthly demand of seventy-five (75) KW or greater with a non-lighting or heat load of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the total demand, and having an average non-coincident load factor of more than thirty-five percent (35%) and to customers presently being served under a contract which provides for billing under this rate.

(E) Purchased Power Adjustment (PPA). In addition to the above compensation, the City of Red Bud, Illinois, shall collect a Purchased Power Adjustment on the sale of each KWH to each customer. For each 0.01 cent increase or decrease or major fraction thereof, in the City's monthly purchased power of 9.50 cents per KWH in the first three (3) of four (4) months preceding the billing period, there shall be correspondingly added to or subtracted from each customer's bill, an amount equal to 0.01 cents per KWH times the total KWH billed to the customers, on all of the above rates.

(G) Rented Dusk-to-Dawn Lights. The rates applicable for dusk-to-dawn lights shall be as follows:

150-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light	\$12.58	per month
150-watt	Equivalent LED Light (50-watt)	\$12.58	per month
250-watt	Equivalent LED Light (82-watt)	\$24.95	per month
400-watt	Equivalent LED Light (133-watt)	\$28.19	per month
1000-watt	Metal Halide Light	\$59.62	per month
1000-watt	Equivalent LED Light (252-watt)	\$59.62	per month
*175-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$12.58	per month
*250-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$24.95	per month
*250-watt	Metal Halide Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$16.20	per month
*400-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$28.19	per month
*400-watt	Metal Halide Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$28.19	per month

SECTION 3: That as of May 1, 2027, Section 71-28 of Title VII, Chapter 71 of the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 of the City of Red Bud, Illinois be repealed and replaced with the following:

71-28: RATES AND CHARGES. For the following classifications of electric service, the rates, based on the conditions and terms as set forth are hereby established for the sale of electric energy to the City's customers unless otherwise agreed upon.

(A) Rate I -- Residential Rate:

Customer Charge	\$13.00 per month
All KW-HRS used per month	\$ 0.1259 per KW-HR

The minimum monthly bill shall be Thirteen Dollars (\$13.00) per month. Rate I shall apply to residences and churches.

(B) Rate II -- Commercial Rate:

Customer Charge	\$23.00 per month
All KW-HRS used per month	\$ 0.1433 per KW-HR

The minimum monthly bill shall be Twenty-Three Dollars (\$23.00) per month. Rate II shall apply to stores, shops, garages, depots, public halls, hospitals, mills, factories, pool rooms, taverns, soft drink parlors, restaurants and other places of business, public resort or amusement.

(C) Rate III -- Small Power Rate:

Customer Charge	\$64.00 per month
All KW-HRS used per month	\$ 0.1257 per KW-HR

The minimum monthly bill shall be Sixty-Four Dollars (\$64.00) per month. Rate III shall apply to all customers, unless otherwise agreed to, having a monthly demand of seventy-five (75) KW or greater with a non-lighting or heat load of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the total demand, and having an average non-coincident load factor of more than thirty-five percent (35%) and to customers presently being served under a contract which provides for billing under this rate.

(G) Rented Dusk-to-Dawn Lights. The rates applicable for dusk-to-dawn lights shall be as follows:

150-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light	\$13.09	per month
150-watt	Equivalent LED Light (50-watt)	\$13.09	per month
250-watt	Equivalent LED Light (82-watt)	\$25.95	per month
400-watt	Equivalent LED Light (133-watt)	\$29.32	per month
1000-watt	Metal Halide Light	\$62.00	per month
1000-watt	Equivalent LED Light (252-watt)	\$62.00	per month
*175-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$13.09	per month
*250-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$25.95	per month
*250-watt	Metal Halide Light

*400-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light

SECTION 4: That as of May 1, 2028, Section 71-28 of Title VII, Chapter 71 of the City of Red Bud Code of Ordinances 2021 of the City of Red Bud, Illinois be repealed and replaced with the following:

71-28: RATES AND CHARGES. For the following classifications of electric service, the rates, based on the conditions and terms as set forth are hereby established for the sale of electric energy to the City's customers unless otherwise agreed upon.

(A) Rate I -- Residential Rate:

Customer Charge	\$14.50 per month
All KW-HRS used per month	\$ 0.1307 per KW-HR

The minimum monthly bill shall be Fourteen Dollars and Fifty-Cents (\$14.50) per month. Rate I shall apply to residences and churches.

(B) Rate II -- Commercial Rate:

Customer Charge	\$24.50 per month
All KW-HRS used per month	\$ 0.1481 per KW-HR

The minimum monthly bill shall be Twenty-Four Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$24.50) per month. Rate II shall apply to stores, shops, garages, depots, public halls, hospitals, mills, factories, pool rooms, taverns, soft drink parlors, restaurants and other places of business, public resort or amusement.

(C) Rate III -- Small Power Rate:

Customer Charge	\$71.00 per month
All KW-HRS used per month	\$ 0.1304 per KW-HR

The minimum monthly bill shall be Seventy-One Dollars (\$71.00) per month. Rate III shall apply to all customers, unless otherwise agreed to, having a monthly demand of seventy-five (75) KW or greater with a non-lighting or heat load of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the total demand, and having an average non-coincident load factor of more than thirty-five percent (35%) and to customers presently being served under a contract which provides for billing under this rate.

(G) Rented Dusk-to-Dawn Lights. The rates applicable for dusk-to-dawn lights shall be as follows:

150-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light	\$13.61	per month
150-watt	Equivalent LED Light (50-watt)	\$13.61	per month
250-watt	Equivalent LED Light (82-watt)	\$26.98	per month
400-watt	Equivalent LED Light (133-watt)	\$30.49	per month
1000-watt	Metal Halide Light	\$64.48	per month
1000-watt	Equivalent LED Light (252-watt)	\$64.48	per month
*175-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$13.61	per month
*250-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$26.98	per month
*250-watt	Metal Halide Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$17.52	per month
*400-watt	High Pressure Sodium Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$30.49	per month
*400-watt	Metal Halide Light (no longer offered but still in service)	\$30.49	per month

SECTION 5: This Ordinance supersedes all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances adopted prior hereto that are in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.


