CHILDREN'S SUPERVISION AND AGE REQUIREMENTS

- An ADULT is defined as a person age 18 or older
- A SUPERVISOR is defined as a person age 16 or older
- Children age 10 and under must have an adult or parent approved supervisor to use the pool.
 - Ages 6-10 may be alone in the water upon successful completion of the pool swim test.
 - Ages 5 & below must have an adult or supervisor in the water within arms reach.
- Children age 11 and older may use the swim facilities independently
- Children of diaper age MUST wear a swim diaper.

Pool Rules

BEHAVIOR AND SWIMMING

- Please walk on the pool deck.
- Diving is not permitted.
- Alcohol and firearms are not permitted on facility grounds.
- Appropriate swim suits/trunks must be worn in the pool.
- All swimmers must take a soap shower before entering the pool.
- Breath holding and long periods of underwater swimming are not permitted.
- Sitting on or hanging on lane lines or lifelines unless a true emergency. Do not remove any lines.
- Inappropriate language is not permitted.
- Only U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets or swim aids permitted. Water wings, rafts and inflatables not permitted.
- Only diapers approved as swim diapers are allowed in the pool.
- Patrons who do not follow the guidance of the lifeguards will be asked to leave with no refund or credit provided.

SAFETY CLOSURES

- Thunder and lightning: The pool will close for a minimum of 30 minutes if a guard hears thunder or sees lightning. The pool will close for the day if weather conditions are hazardous.
- Obstructed view: if weather or water conditions impact the lifeguard's ability to see the bottom of the pool, the pool will close until the obstruction is remedied.
- Water contamination may cause the pool area to close without notice. This is in accordance with Health Department guidelines and is for the safety of everyone.
