III. Approval of Bid for Rock Hill/Theodore Street Improvement Project – Huebner Concrete Construction, Inc., for \$61,182

Motion made by Council Member Nevois, seconded by Council Member Hanebutt, to authorize approval to accept the bid from Huebner Concrete Construction, Inc., for the Rock Hill/Theodore Street improvement project for \$61,182. IV. Public/Guest Comment

Council Member Nevois stated that as the one-year anniversary of the death of his and Kim's son, Cameron Nevois will be in September, and he and Kim have set up a charitable foundation in memory of Cameron, with the proceeds to be split between the Muskets and the Red Bud Community Foundation. The Red Bud Chamber of Commerce has been working on raising donations for a "Welcome to the BUD" monument for somewhere in the downtown area. The Red Bud Community Foundation will cover the cost for the monument, concrete, and lighting in memory of Cameron. The piece is being designed by Roeslein and can be ready by the August 29th America 250 Community Event. Potential sites for the monument are in the front of the Dieterich Bank gazebo, between Alan Mueth's building and the old barber shop and between the Carnahan Market on Main building and the dentist office. The Chamber would still like it on the Theilen wall in front of the city parking lot by

TuLayne's. The property owners would be happy to have the sign on their property. Rick Stenzel has offered his property at Spring and West Market. The city hall park was also suggested.
