I. Approval of Prior Month's Meeting Minutes – July 20, 2026

II. Pool Post Season Repairs Proposal from Haier Plumbing & Heating, Inc., NTE \$7,700

Superintendent Eckart noted that IDPH approval is not required because it is general repairs. He also noted that the previous work done had taken care of the problems and the pool had a good season. The work will be done after the pool is closed for the season.

Administrative Officer Landgraf explained the Lincoln Park Master Plan prepared by Farnsworth and what would be included in the OSLAD grant proposal for \$1,200,000 with a 50% match (\$600,000) required of the city. The grant proposal is due August 31, 2026. The tennis court/skate park will be moved to flatter ground, as the current space has issues due to underground springs.
